- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Isolation of Clostridium Botulinum from clinical specimen
- Detection of botulinum toxin in clinical specimen

Condition Specific Reporting Details

 Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records
- CDC Botulism Case Report form
- Documentation of release of botulism antitoxin from CDC or <u>CDPH Infant</u> <u>Botulism Treatment and</u> <u>Prevention Program</u>
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
