Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

• Serum total antibody titers to *Brucella spp*. by standard tube agglutination testing (SAT) or *Brucella* microagglutination testing (BMAT), or detection of *Brucella spp*. DNA by PCR or bacterial isolation of *Brucella spp*.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

 Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries
- Travel history and known animal exposures
- Name and contact information of follow-up provider should be listed in the administrative comments section of the morbidity report
