#### **Condition Name:**

Escherichia coli (E. coli) infection (Shiga toxin-producing E. coli (STEC))

#### **Condition Name in NBS:**

Shiga toxin-producing *Escherichia* coli (STEC)

## **Reporting Timeframe:**

Within One Working Day

# TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u> form

### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

- Isolation or detection of Escherichia coli (E. coli) O157 in a clinical specimen
- Detection of Shiga toxin or Shiga toxin genes in a clinical specimen
- Detection of non-O157 E. coli STEC/Enterohemorrhagic E. coli (EHEC) in a clinical specimen

### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

 Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
