## Condition Name:

**Streptococcus, Group A,  
invasive disease**

## Condition Name in NBS:

**Streptococcal disease,  
invasive, Group A**

## Reporting Timeframe:

**Within One Working Day**

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Streptococcus* group A (*Streptococcus pyogenes*) identified by culture or PCR from a normally sterile body site or from any site in cases of streptococcal toxic shock syndrome (STSS) or necrotizing fasciitis.
- Also submit results of any antimicrobial susceptibility testing.

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Relevant clinical documentation, if available.
- If admitted to or visited a healthcare facility prior to symptom onset, please provide facility name and address. This includes long-term care, assisted living, clinics, hospitals, or rehabilitation facilities.
