#### **Associated Reportable Laboratory Results**

• Positive serologic test, biopsy of Trichinella larvae in human or in food item

#### **Condition Specific Reporting Details**

Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

#### **Additional Documentation to Include**

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and Emergency Department/Hospital Discharge Summaries.
- Known animal exposures
