Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in NBS
- Non-NBS users: Report with <u>this</u>

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

Vancomycin resistant Staphylococcus aureus (VRSA) and Vancomycin intermediate Staphylococcus aureus (VISA) from any site

Condition Specific Reporting Details

• Clinical, Epidemiological, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Completed <u>VISA/VRSA Reporting Form</u>
- Culture and antimicrobial susceptibility results
- History and physical, most recent admission and discharge notes, any Infection disease doctor's note
