Antimicrobial Stewardship: Ensuring Safe and Effective Treatment

- Antimicrobial stewardship involves having the correct diagnosis, appropriate dosage, duration, and timing of antibiotic prescriptions
- Dental professionals play a crucial role in stewardship by prescribing antibiotics only when clinically necessary
- By practicing antibiotic stewardship, dental professionals help prevent antimicrobial resistance and safe guard patient health

Together, we can ensure the responsible use of antibiotics in dentistry for better patient outcomes and long –term effectiveness of treatment.



What can dental providers do?

- Assess patient's medical and dental history before prescribing antibiotics
- Consider therapeutic treatment methods for localized oral bacterial infections
- Weigh potential benefits and risks (toxicity, adverse effects, etc.) of antibiotics for each patient before prescribing
- Keep antibiotic references on current evidence based practices in examination rooms during patient visits
- **Educate staff** on proper antibiotic use to increase the chance of patient adherence to prescription instructions
- **Educate patients** on taking antibiotics as prescribed
- Discuss antibiotic use with referring specialists

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
