Summary of changes to the Indiana Reportable Disease List for Healthcare Providers and Hospitals

- Diseases that are newly reportable
 - Chapare virus
 - Grouped under "Viral hemorrhagic fever, other"
 - Heartland virus
 - Grouped under "Arboviral disease or infection, domestic"
 - New World screwworm myiasis
 - Primary amebic meningoencephalitis (*Naegleria fowleri*)
 - Rift Valley fever virus
 - Grouped under "Viral hemorrhagic fever, other"
- Diseases with updated reporting timeframe (now within one working day)
 - Eastern equine encephalitis virus
 - Grouped under "Arboviral disease or infection, domestic"
 - Hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), post-diarrheal
 - Hepatitis, viral, Type B, pregnant woman or perinatally exposed infant
- Diseases with format/wording changes only
 - Hantavirus pulmonary syndrome and non-pulmonary syndrome
 - Previously Hantavirus infection (pulmonary and non-pulmonary), including, but not limited to: Sin Nombre virus, Seoul virus
 - Hepatitis, viral, Type B, pregnant woman or perinatally exposed infant
 - Previously Hepatitis, viral, Type B, pregnant woman (acute and chronic) or perinatally exposed infant
 - Hepatitis, viral, Type C, pregnant woman or perinatally exposed infant
 - Previously Hepatitis, viral, Type C, pregnant woman (acute and chronic) or perinatally exposed infant
 - Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS-CoV)
 - Previously Middle East respiratory syndrome coronavirus (MERS-CoV)
 - Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS-CoV)
 - Previously SARS-associated coronavirus (SARS-CoV)
 - Syphilis, Congenital (pregnant woman and/or infant)
 - Previously listed under Syphilis, updated to a new separate category
- Other
 - Added clarifying footnote on reporting HIV infection directly to the Indiana Department of Health

Summary of changes to the Indiana Reportable Result/Pathogen List for Laboratories

- Results that are newly reportable
 - Chapare virus
 - Grouped under "Viral hemorrhagic fever, other"
 - *Cochliomyia hominivorax*
 - Heartland virus
 - Grouped under "Arboviruses including, but not limited to:"
 - *Naegleria fowleri*
 - Rift Valley fever virus
 - Grouped under "Viral hemorrhagic fever, other"
- Results removed
 - West African monkeypox virus
- Results with updated reporting timeframe (now within one working day)
 - Hepatitis, viral, Type B, pregnant woman (acute and chronic) or perinatally exposed infant
 - Now included with "Hepatitis, viral, Type B" rather than being listed separately
- Results previously reportable that have been modified in scope
 - Footnote added to HIV and related retroviruses; a section on page 2 was added to expand on reporting requirements specifications
- Updated and reformatted list of isolates that must be submitted to the IDOH Laboratory within three business days
 - Added *Neisseria gonorrhoeae*, disseminated infection
- Results with format/wording changes only
 - Hantavirus, including Sin Nombre virus, Seoul virus, and other hantaviruses
 - Previously Hantavirus
