

LTBI Reporting for IPs in NBS Quick Guide



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When to Submit an LTBI Morbidity Report

Open an LTBI Morbidity Report in NBS when **1)** the patient has a positive TST and/or a positive IGRA, **and 2)** the patient has normal imaging or abnormal imaging with TB disease ruled out **and/or 3)** patient has been fully evaluated and diagnosed with LTBI.

Do not submit an LTBI Morbidity Report for a patient under suspicion of having TB disease.

To submit an LTBI Morbidity Report in NBS:

- Locate the patient record by using *Patient Search*
- Select the *Events* tab on the patient record
- Select *Add New* under Morbidity Reports
- Select *Latent Tuberculosis Infection* from the dropdown

Completing an LTBI Morbidity Report

- 1.** Complete required variables: Jurisdiction, Morbidity Report Type, Date of Morbidity Report and Reporting Facility.
- 2.** **SKIP Clinical Information, Epidemiological Information, Lab Report Information and Treatment Information.**
- 3.** Attach completed [Report of LTBI](#) and relevant documentation (Radiography, IGRA and/or TST and Treatment Information, including DOT records) under Attachment Information.
