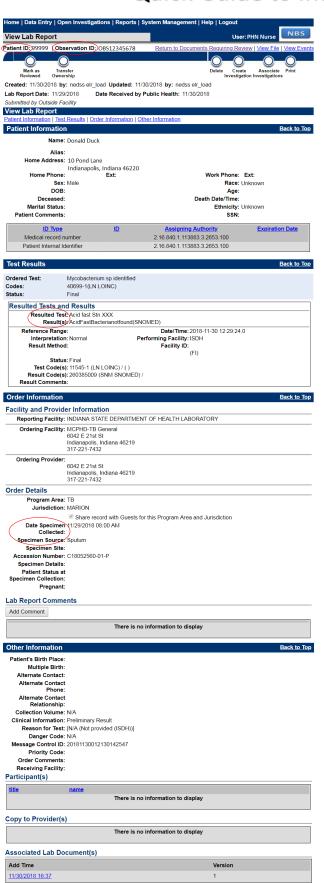
Quick Guide to Interpreting TB Labs in NBS



The first section of data provides information about the lab electronic process and patient demographics. **Patient ID** and **Observation ID** (circled) are 2 identifiers that can be used to find the patient or lab in NBS.

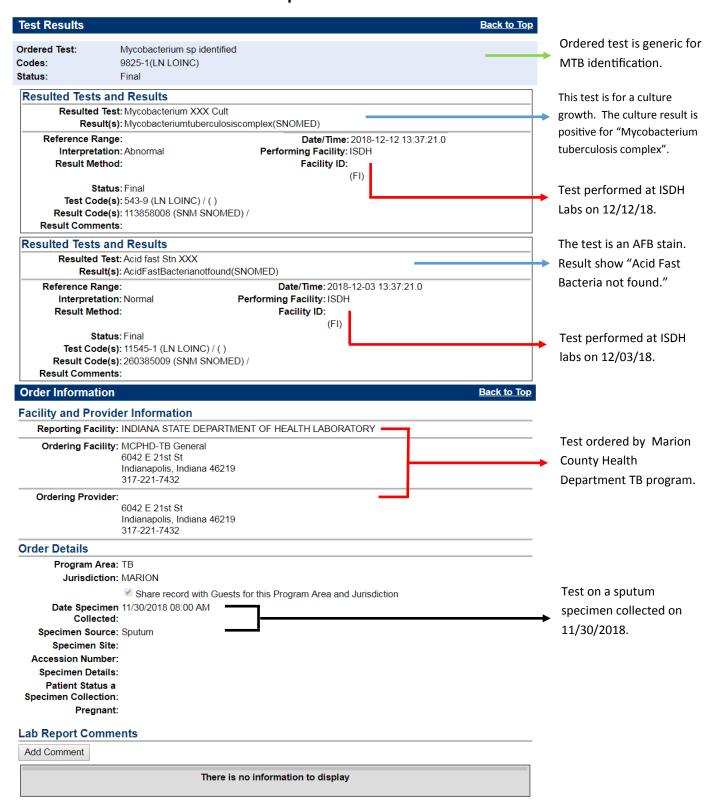
Patient demographics can be found under Patient Information. This also includes IDs for the Medical Record Number, Account Number or Patient Internal Identifier (or the lab ascension number).

Lab tests and results will be displayed under Test Results Section of the lab report. The two fields that will be important to look at are **Resulted Test** and **Result(s)**. The Resulted Test will identify the specific test that was performed and the **Result(s)** will display the result of that test. Other information regarding lab date and facility is also found here.

Order Information provides information about ordering provider and facility. The section will also contain information about the **specimen collected** (circled) for the test including the type of specimen and the date it was collected. The lab ascension number can also be found here.

The Other Information section provides further demographic information about the patient and lab.

Example of TB Labs in NBS

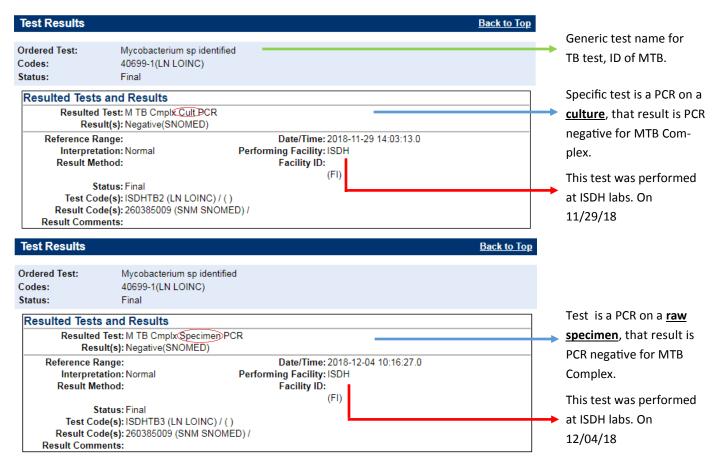


Ordered Test: Broad information about test(s) ordered.

Resulted Test and Results: Detailed information for test and test results. Text may appear in **Reference Range** and may look like a result but is not, make sure to use text in **Result(s)** field.

Facility and Provider Information: Provides information about facility and provider

Order details: Provides information regarding specimen collection and source.



<u>Note:</u> ISDH can perform PCR on a culture or a raw specimen. The <u>Resulted Test</u> field will have a text that identifies if it is for Culture or Specimen as shown above.

<u>Note:</u> Test names can differ depending on where the test is performed. For example, this test from Columbus Regional Hospital is labeled as AFB stain and labeled as such in the Ordered Test, where as ISDH labs uses "Mycobacterium sp Identified" as Ordered Test name for their TB tests.

^{*}Not all lab results will come into the NBS system looking clean like the ones in this guide. There can be missing information, wrong test codes, data being inputted into the wrong fields, truncated results and other issues that may lead to a lab not being interpreted correctly. Any lab issues should be directed to the ISDH TB Program.
