Provider materials	<p><b>Screening for Social Determinants of Health</b>            The Accountable Health Communities (AHC) Health- Related Social Needs (HRSN) Screening Tool is used to screen for unmet HRSNs like homelessness, hunger and exposure to violence which if addressed can lead to undoing harm to their health. The provider can use the results from the screening tool to inform patient's treatment plan and make referrals to community services.
