## **Healthcare Worker Vaccination Requirement**

CMS issued on May 31 a final rule regarding the healthcare worker vaccination requirement. Since facilities are no longer operating under a PHE and considering the lower policy priority of enforcement, surveyors will not review or cite to the healthcare worker vaccination requirements from this point forward. Tag F888 has been removed from the long-term care survey process (LTCSP), and the entrance conference form and infection control pathway have been updated for surveyors. ### **Free Virtual Courses for Skilled Nursing Facility Personnel**

The Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) and the University of Indianapolis Center for Aging & Community are offering cost-free virtual courses for skilled nursing facility personnel in three subject areas relevant to the long term care setting. The courses are:
