Pursuant to the "Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak" issued by Governor Eric Holcomb on March 6, 2020 and IC4-21.5-4-1, and as authorized by IC 16-28-1-10 and the September 18, 1991 resolution of the Executive Board of the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), the Indiana Health Commissioner hereby ORDERs as follows:

- 1. Living Arrangements
- 2. Transfer and Discharge Rights
- 3. Personnel
- 4. Personnel
- 5. Physician Services
- 6. Activities
- 7. Dining Assistant

# **Emergency Order Authorizing Temporary Personal Care Attendant Position and Training for Nursing Homes**

Pursuant to the "Declaration of Public Health Emergency for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak" issued by Governor Eric Holcomb on March 6, 2020 (the "Governor's Declaration") and IC4-21.5-4-1 the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), the Indiana Health Commissioner hereby ORDERs as follows effective retroactively as of March 6, 2020:

 Licensed Indiana comprehensive care facilities, as a supplement to personnel may train and subsequently utilize temporary Personal Care Aides (PCA).
