## **COVID-19 Guidance for Hospital Discharge to LTC Facilities**

This guidance is consistent with the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and was done in collaboration with Indiana's hospital and longterm care organizations. The purpose of this document is to provide guidance to longterm care facilities (LTCFs), including nursing facilities and skilled nursing facilities, about discharging, admitting, and readmitting a resident from a hospital who has presumed or confirmed COVID-19. This guidance is based on currently available information about COVID-19 and will be refined and updated as more information becomes available and response needs change in Indiana.
