## **Aerosolizing Respiratory Treatment in LTC**

There are some shifts to how health care providers must deliver care to meet the needs of residents and minimize risk of disease transmission during the COVID-19 pandemic. One key area is how we are delivering respiratory treatments that are known to aerosolize respiratory particles during administration. This includes administration of inhaled medications via nebulizer therapy and non-invasive airway support via C-PAP and Bi-PAP to residents with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 infection. Guidelines recommend these treatments should be performed in a negative pressure isolation room for people who are COVID positive and these rooms are not in any long term care facilities.
