Environmental Steps to Reduce Indoor COVID-19 Transmission Guidance

COVID-19 is a highly infectious viral illness that is spread by respiratory droplets. While the risk of outbreaks can be reduced by infection control measures (e.g., hand washing, face covering), indoor airflow patterns can also contribute to virus particle spread. Airflow can increase the transmission of viruses. This guidance provides recommendations related to open windows, increased humidity, open blinds, air conditioning and filters that can be used in congregate setting to decrease viral transmission.
