- **Revised LTC Abuse and Incident Reporting Policy**

Revised LTC Abuse and Incident Reporting Policy

In response to long-term care regulation changes, the Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) Division of Long-Term Care (LTC) has revised its policy related to reporting of abuse, incidents, and other unusual occurrences by licensed comprehensive care and licensed residential facilities.

The new policy, "[IDOH LTC Abuse and Incident Reporting Policy](#)" includes, but is not limited to, term definitions, instructions for submitting a report, regulatory guidance, and description of reportable events. The policy is effective Dec. 8.
