## Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome Clinical Definition

- In utero Exposure to opioids with or without other psychotropic substances
- Clinical signs characteristic of substance withdrawal;
  any 2 of the following five signs qualify:
  - Excessive crying (easily irritable)
  - Fragmented sleep (<2-3 hours after feeding)</li>
  - Tremors (disturbed or undisturbed)
  - Increased muscle tone (stiff muscles)
  - Gastrointestinal dysfunction (hyperphagia, poor feeding, feeding intolerance, loose or watery stools)

The diagnosis is a separate issue from the treatment methodology.
