**Questions to consider using for debriefing:** (This list does not reflect all possible debriefing questions.)

- 1. Tell me what happened in the scenario
- 2. How did this feel to you?
- 3. Did you have all the equipment and personnel you needed? If not, what would you have needed?
- 4. Did you know how to put together and utilize the equipment?
- 5. What went well?
- 6. What would you do differently?
- 7. What resources did you utilize? Are there resources available that you could have used?
- 8. What was one take-away?
- 9. Any system issues or changes affecting this scenario?
- 10. Were roles identified? Did everyone know their role?
- 11. Tell me about the communication during this scenario.
- 12. Can you reflect on the dynamics of the team?
- 13. This patient needed MBTP; what does that mean for you/your facility? Is the patient stable enough to remain in your facility or do they need to be transferred to a higher level of care?
- 14. When initiating MBTP, what should you consider (what blood products are available/what is the algorithm/are the recommendations in your protocol OB specific)?
- 15. What resources are available to assist you in knowing your blood product ratios and MBTP process?
- 16. When thinking about this patient, what are some other important considerations? (i.e., unit staffing/medical provider/ancillary support availability)
- 17. How did you provide holistic care during this scenario? Was patient/family communication provided?
