Naloxone Reporting Requirements per Indiana Code



IC 16-31-3-23.7 (A)

Requires that any:

Advanced emergency medical technician, community corrections officer, emergency medical responder, emergency medical technician, firefighter, volunteer firefighter, law enforcement officer, paramedic, or probation officer who:

- (1) administers an overdose intervention drug OR (2) is summoned after an overdose intervention drug is administered;
- (2) Must inform the emergency ambulance service responsible for submitting the report to the commission of the number of times an overdose intervention drug has been administered.





IC 16-31-3-23.7 (B)

Requires that:

the emergency ambulance service to include information from **Section A** on their report to the Indiana Emergency Medical Services Commission in accordance with the commission's rules.
