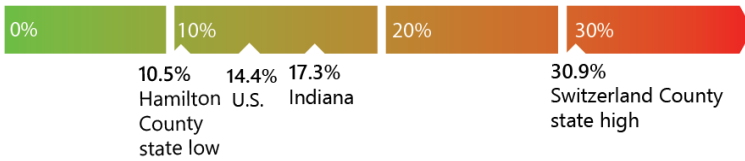

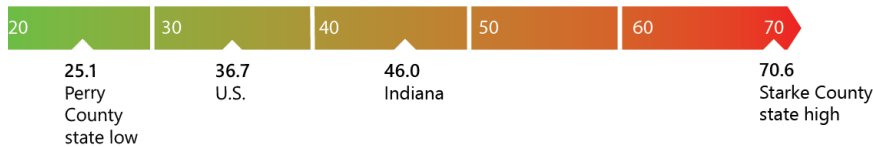

Tobacco and Health in Adams County

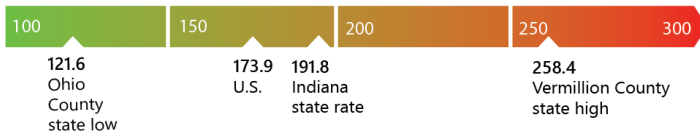
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.3%**



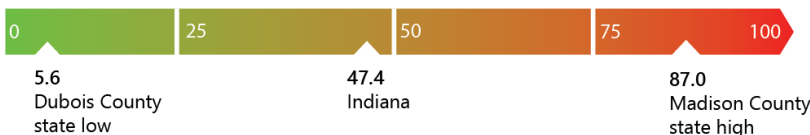
 **Lung cancer deaths**
