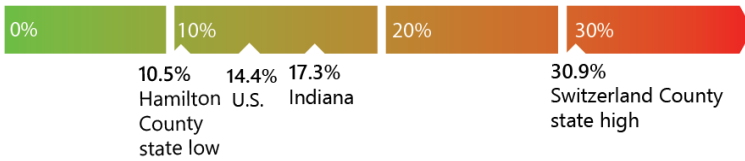

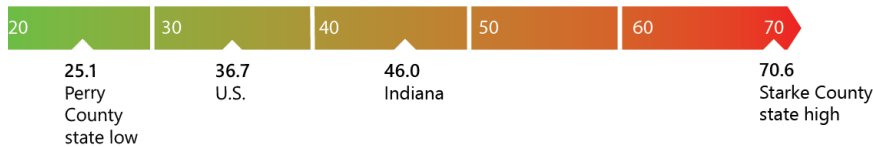

Tobacco and Health in Boone County

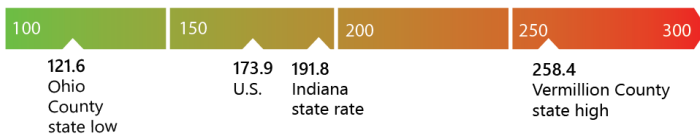
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **12.1%**



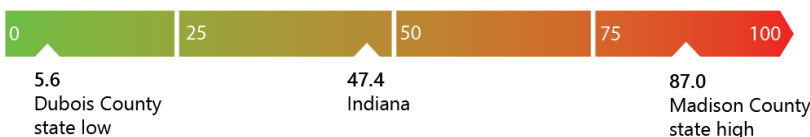
