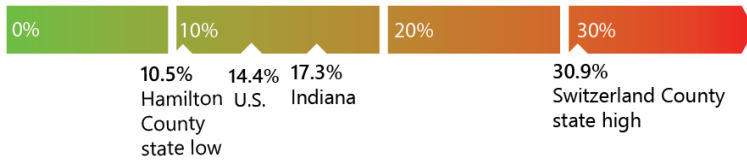

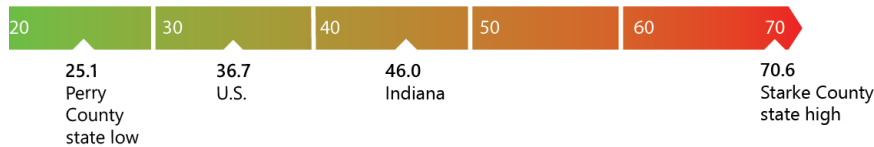

Tobacco and Health in Carroll County

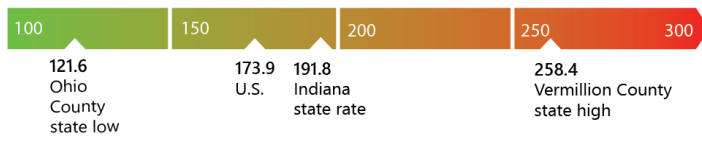
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.6%**



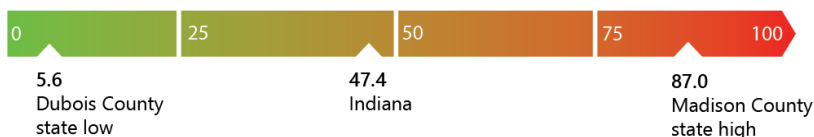
 **Lung cancer deaths**
