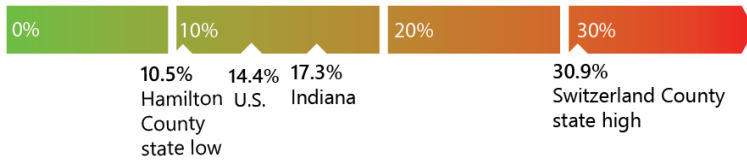

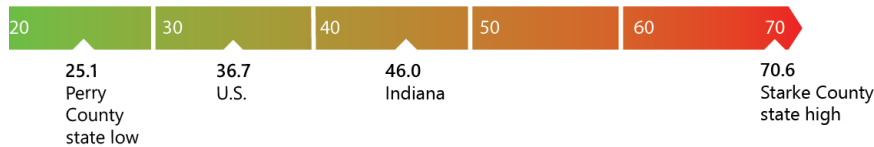
There is no tobacco control grant in «County» for 2021-2023.

## Tobacco and Health in Cass County

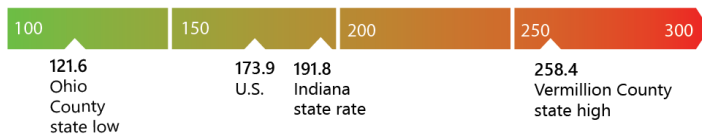
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.8%**



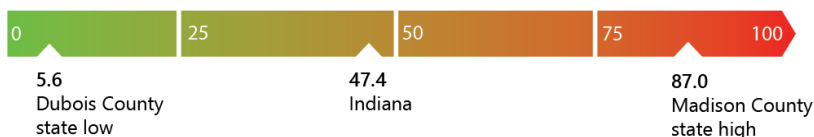
 **Lung cancer deaths**
