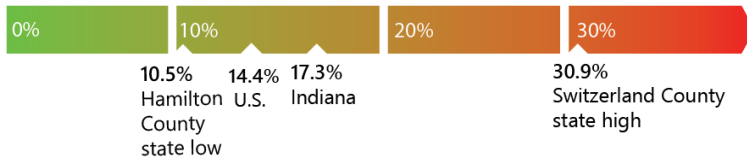

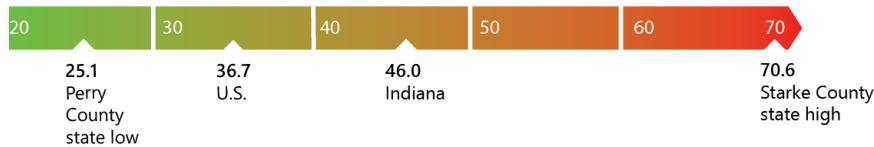

Tobacco and Health in Clay County

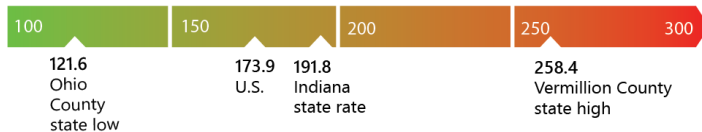
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.0%**



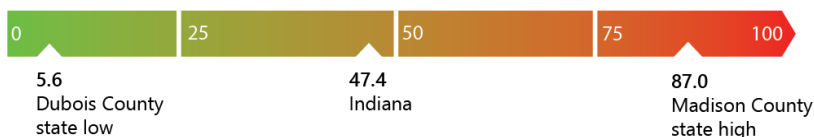
 **Lung cancer deaths** **67.9**
