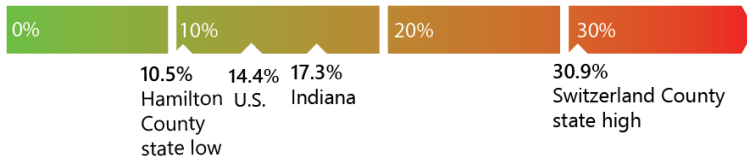

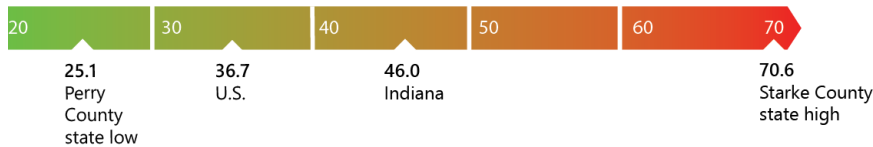

Tobacco and Health in Clinton County

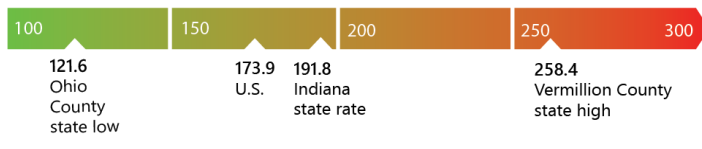
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.6%**



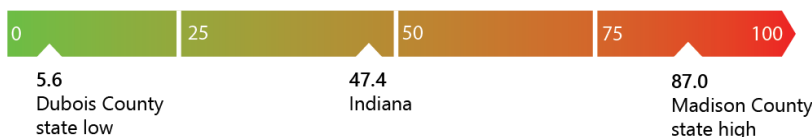
 **Lung cancer deaths** **51.6**
