

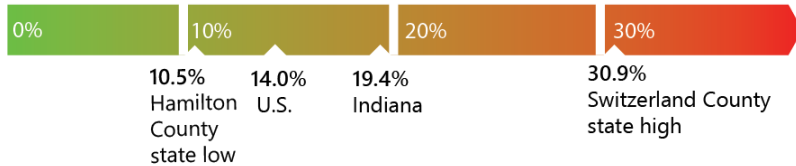

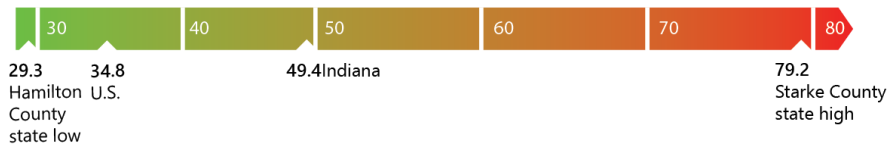
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## Tobacco and Health in Daviness County

**Births affected by smoking** **45**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$61,110**
