

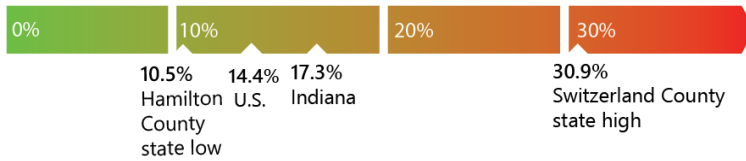

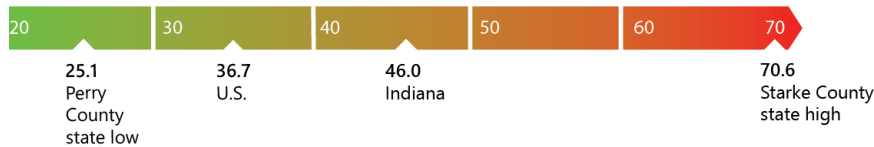

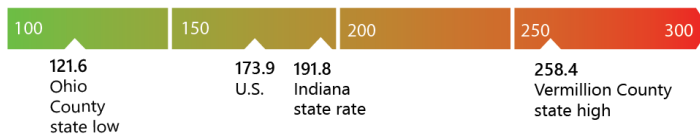
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.3%**



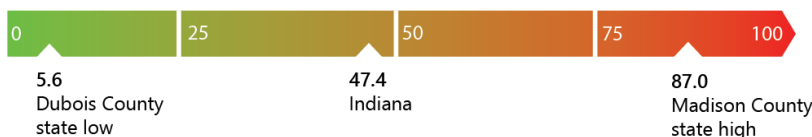
 **Lung cancer deaths**
