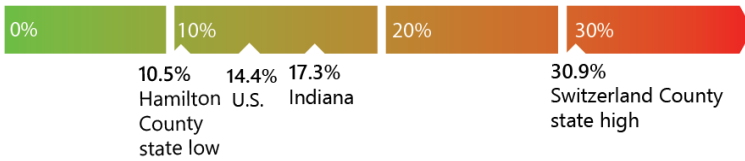

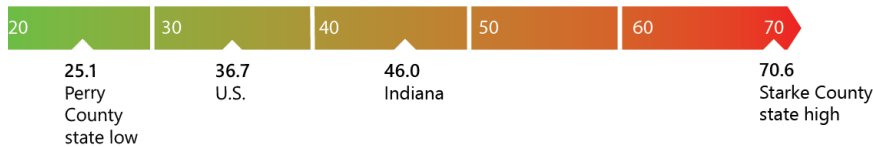

Tobacco and Health in Dubois County

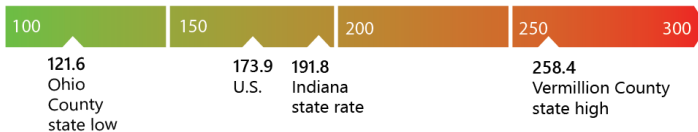
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.3%**



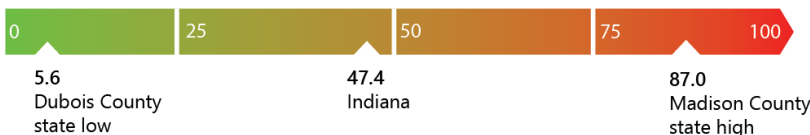
 **Lung cancer deaths**
