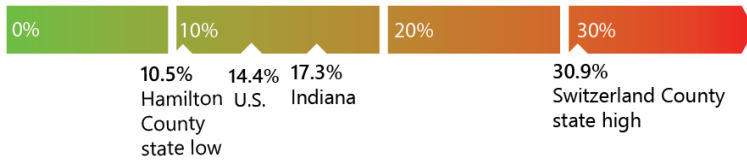

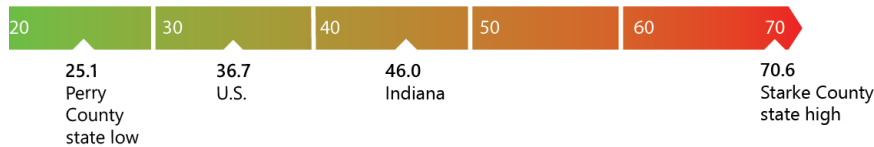

## Tobacco and Health in Fulton County

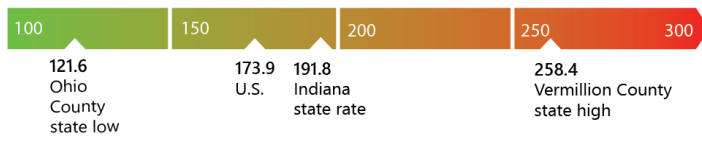
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.5%**



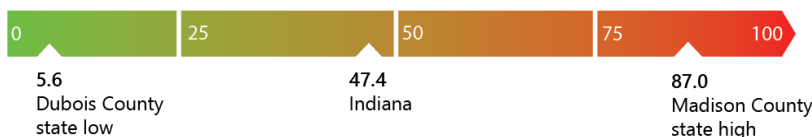
