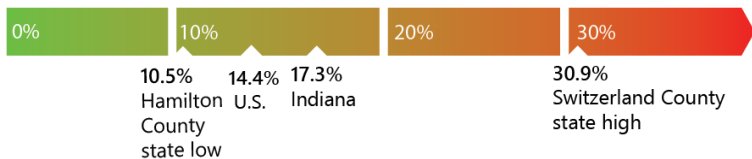

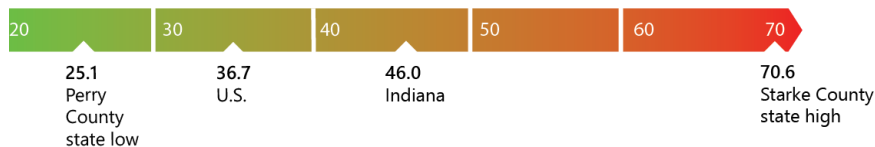
**Percent of adults who smoke**

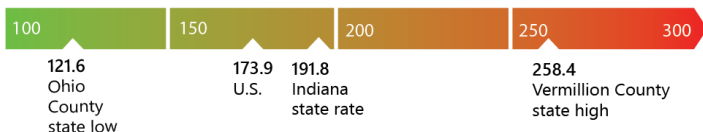

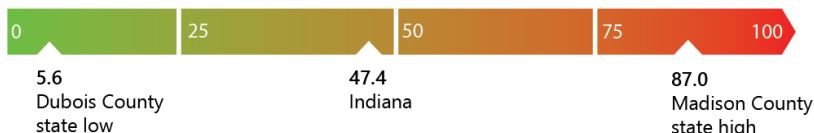
