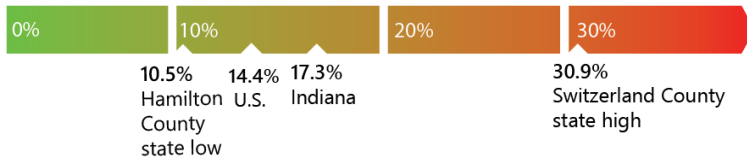

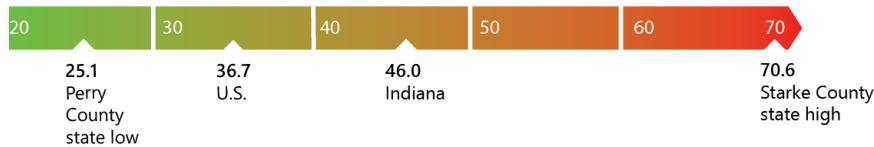

Tobacco and Health in Greene County

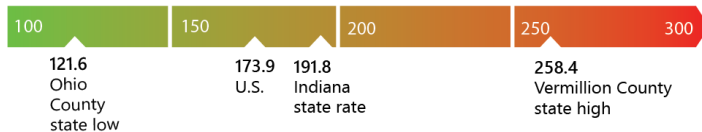
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.0%**



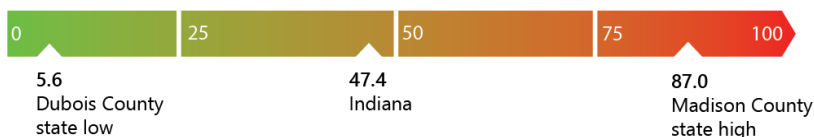
 **Lung cancer deaths** **60.3**
