

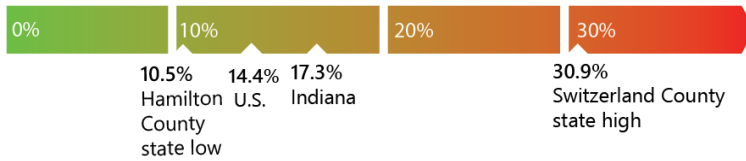

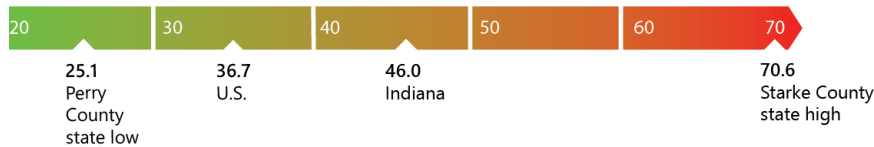

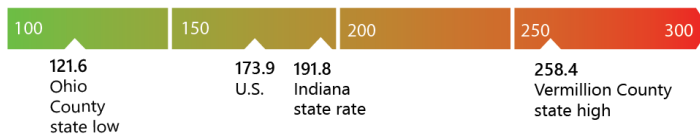
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **10.5%**



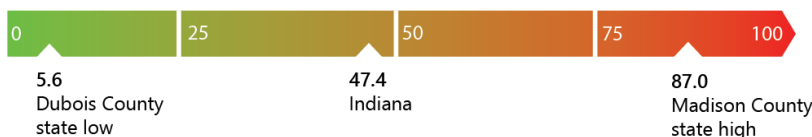
 **Lung cancer deaths** **25.5**
