

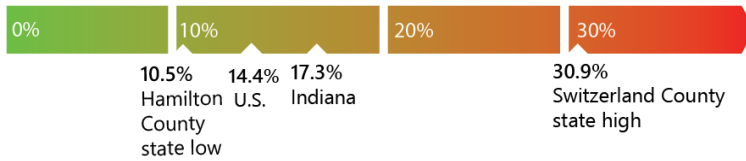

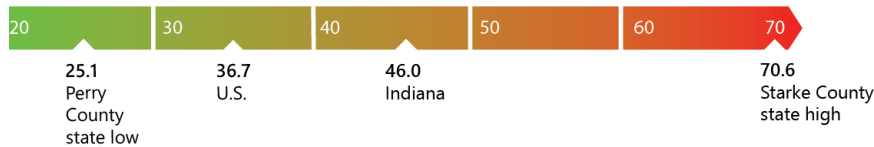

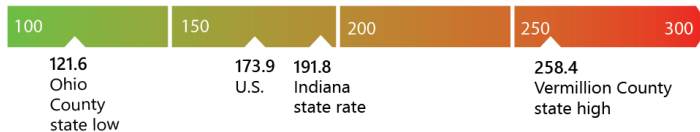
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **11.6%**



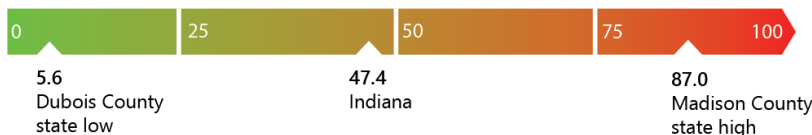
 **Lung cancer deaths**
