### Smoking and Pregnancy

**Births affected by smoking** **67**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$90,986**

**Percent of pregnant women who smoke:**  
Indiana: **11.8%**  
Hancock County: **7.9%**

**Deaths attributable to smoking** **131**

**Deaths due to secondhand smoke** **21**

**Economic burden of secondhand smoke: \$25.8 Million**
