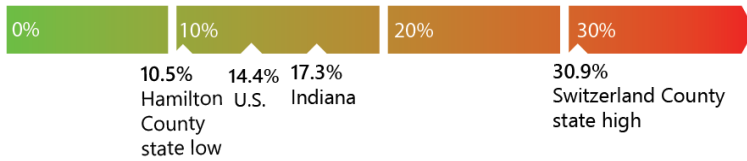

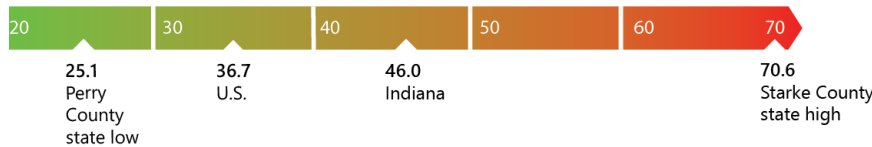

Tobacco and Health in Henry County

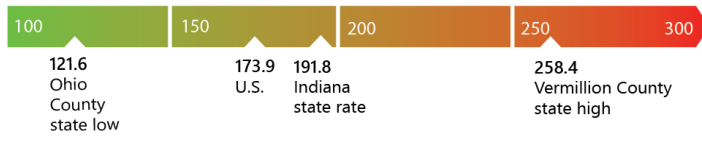
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **25.0%**



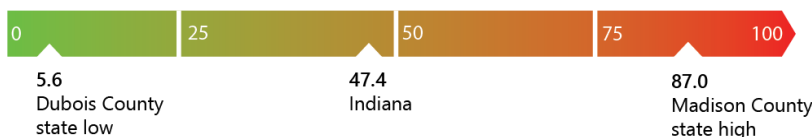
 **Lung cancer deaths**
