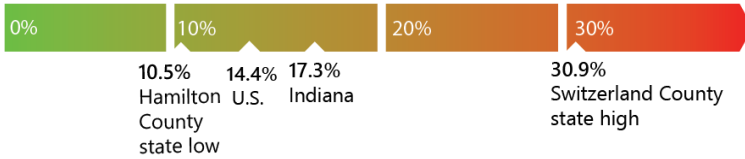

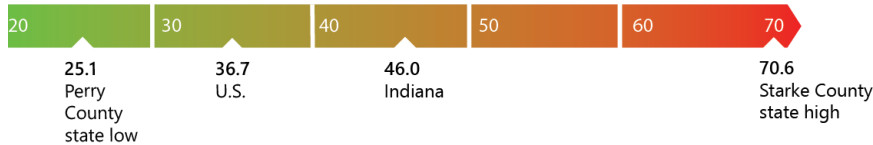

Tobacco and Health in Huntington County

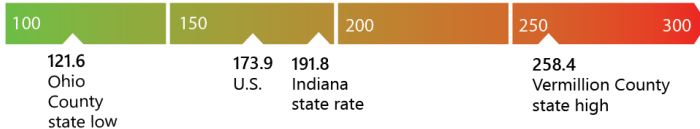
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **24.4%**



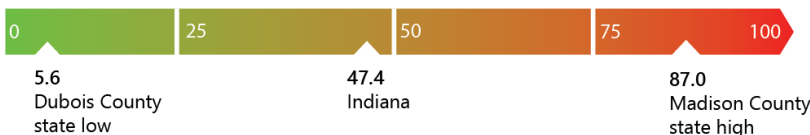
