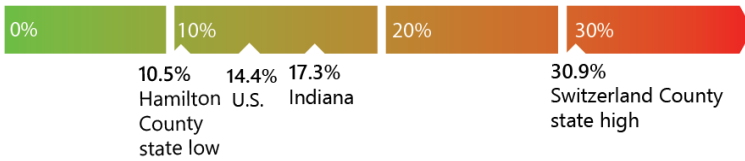

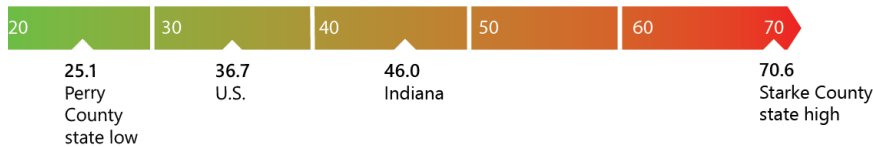

Tobacco and Health in Jasper County

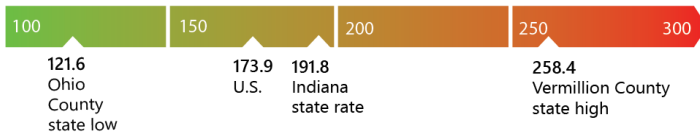
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **25.6%**



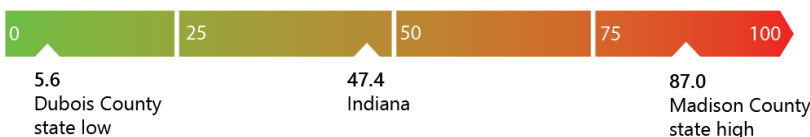
 **Lung cancer deaths**
