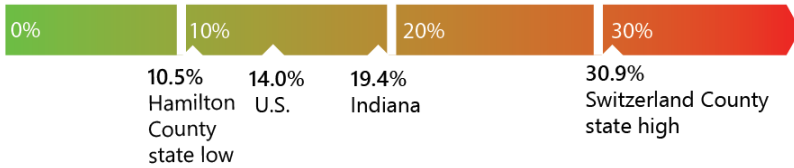

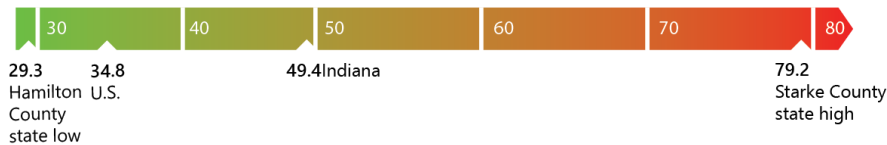
There is no tobacco control grant in Jasper County for 2021-2023.
