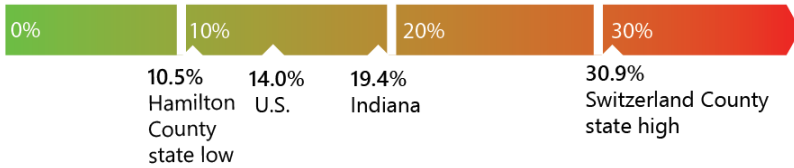

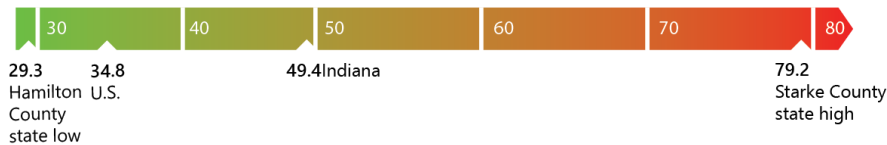
There is no tobacco control grant in Jennings County for 2021-2023.
