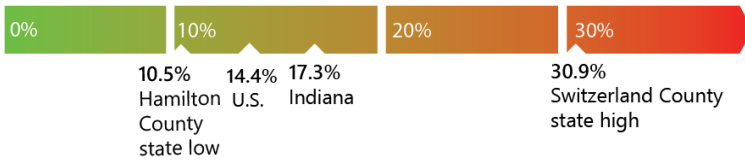

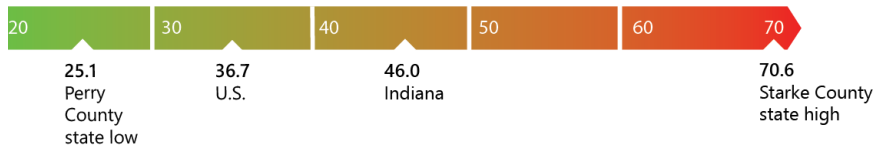

## Tobacco and Health in Johnson County

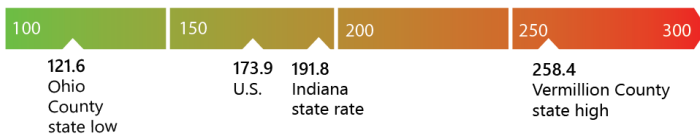
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **20.0%**



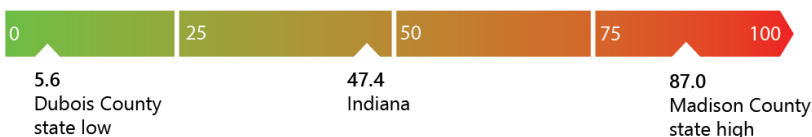
 **Lung cancer deaths**
