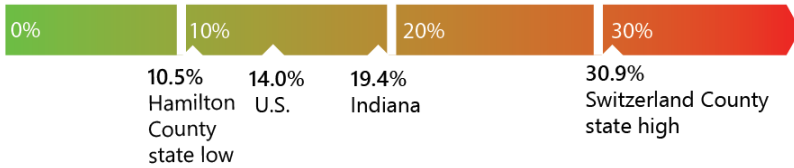


The state of tobacco control LaGrange County

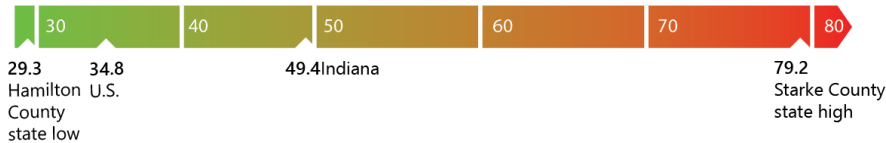
There is no tobacco control grant in LaGrange County for 2021-2023.

Births affected by smoking **45**
low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function

Cost of smoking related births **\$61,110**
