

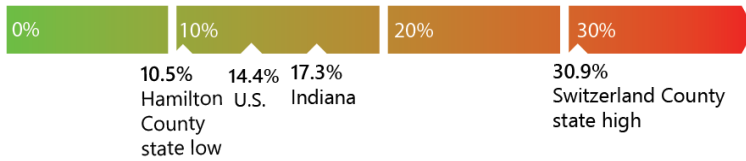

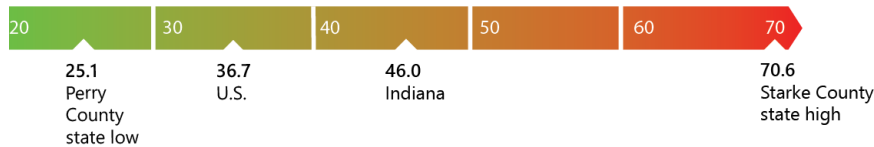

## Tobacco and Health in Marshall County

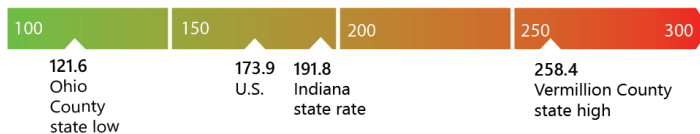
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **23.0%**



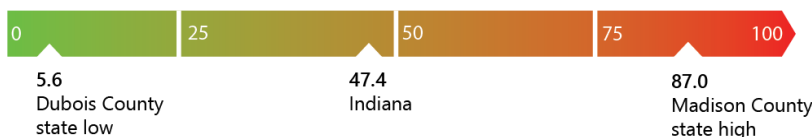
 **Lung cancer deaths**
