

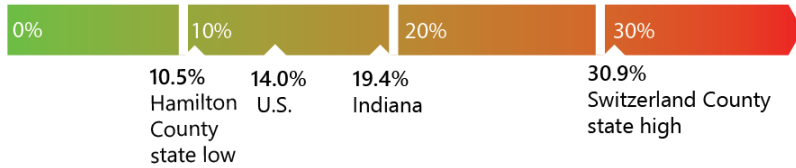

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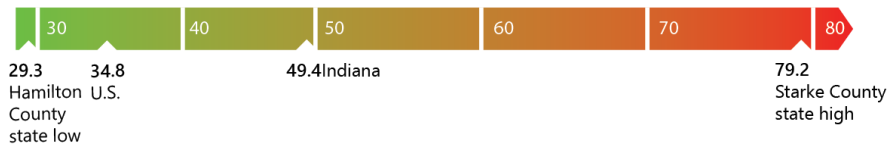
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## Tobacco and Health in Monroe County

### Smoking and Pregnancy

**Births affected by smoking**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function* **140**

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$190,120**

**Percent of pregnant women who smoke:**  
Indiana: **11.8%**  
Monroe County: **12.9%**



### Smoking deaths

**Deaths attributable to smoking** **229**

**Deaths due to secondhand smoke** **36**

**Economic burden of secondhand smoke: \$45.2 Million**



**Smoking related illness** **6,857**

## Tobacco Control Funding
