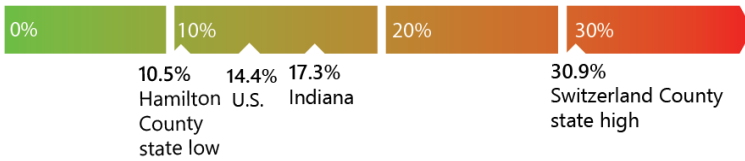

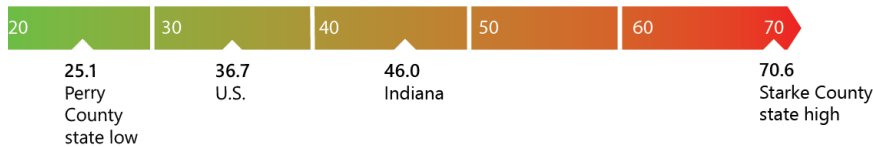

## Tobacco and Health in Montgomery County

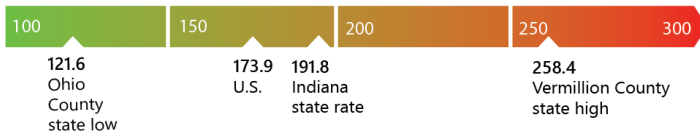
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **20.3%**



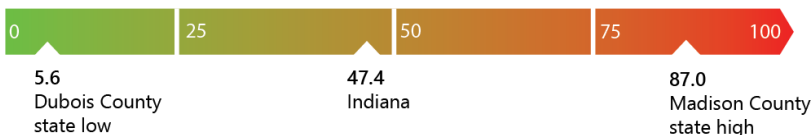
 **Lung cancer deaths**
