

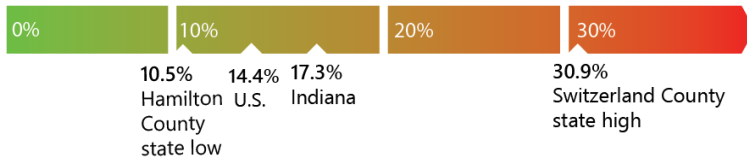

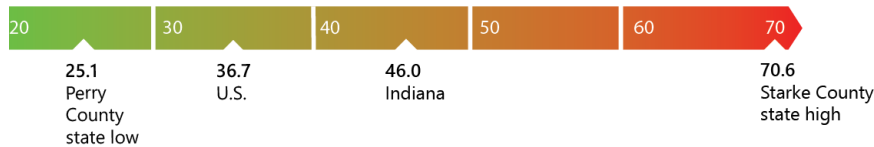

## Tobacco and Health in Orange County

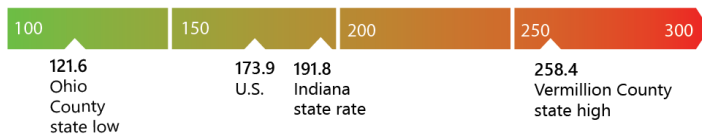
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.8%**



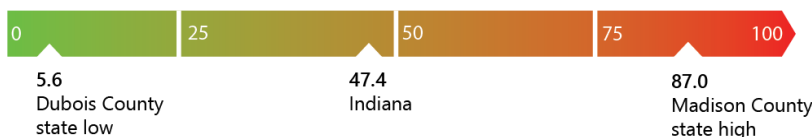
 **Lung cancer deaths**
