### Smoking and Pregnancy

**Births affected by smoking** **60**  
*low birth weight, SIDS, reduced lung function*

**Cost of smoking related births** **\$81,480**

**Percent of pregnant women who smoke:**  
Indiana: **11.8%**  
Orange County: **25.2%**

**Deaths attributable to smoking** **32**

**Deaths due to secondhand smoke** **5**

**Economic burden of secondhand smoke: \$6.4 Million**
