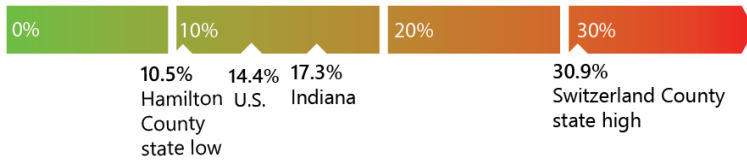

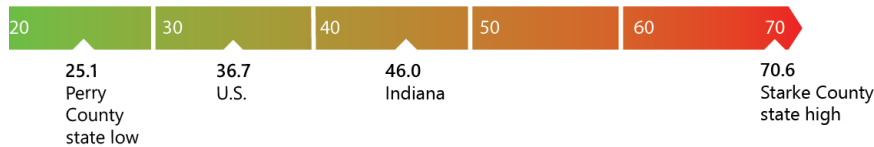

Tobacco and Health in Perry County

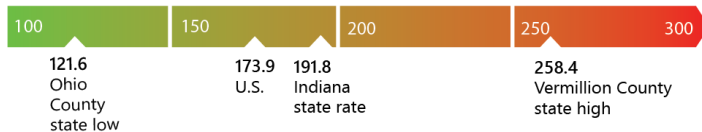
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.3%**



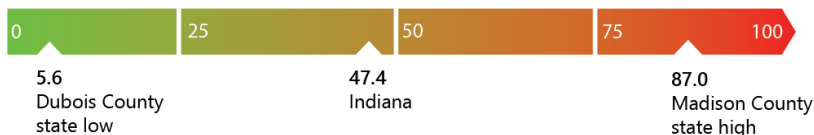
