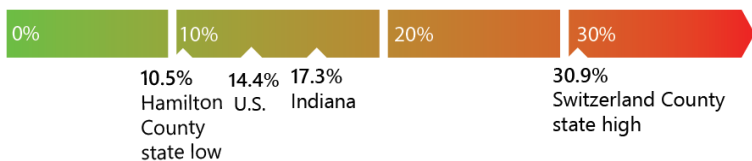

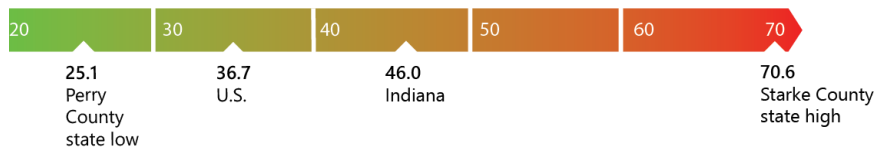

Tobacco and Health in Putnam County

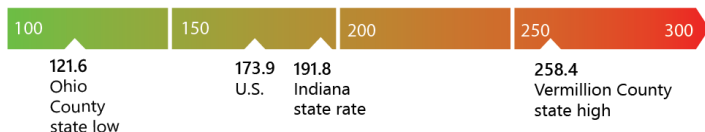
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.9%**



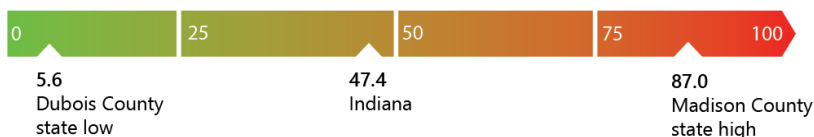
 **Lung cancer deaths**
