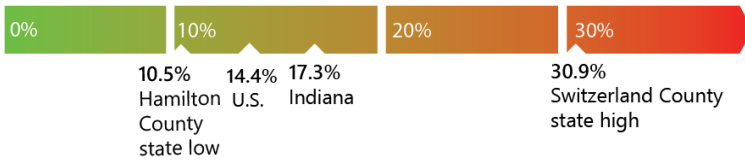

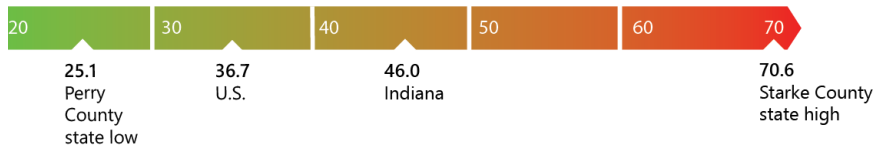

Tobacco and Health in Steuben County

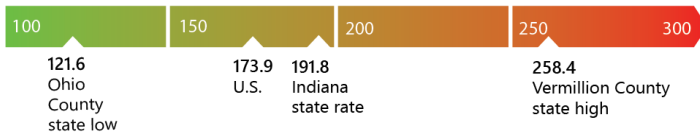
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **21.6%**



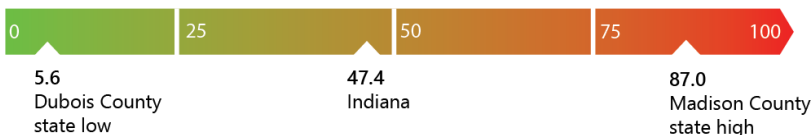
